Little Friends Scholarship Overview

The Little Friends Scholarship assists children affected by domestic and family violence to either further their education and/or be able to participate in extra-curricula activities that they may not be able to pursue due to the financial impact of Domestic and Family Violence within their family environment.

One of the key goals of Friends With Dignity is to support children in Domestic and Family Violence effected environments to go on and live happy healthy and inclusive lives. These scholarships in particular are specifically for children financially impacted by Domestic and Family Violence.

The selection process is detailed and taken very seriously, we aim to support those most in need based on the information provided to us.

Scholarships are provided on a bi-annual basis and are categorised into 2 support categories as below:

♥ Educational

The Educational category may include, but is not limited to, textbooks, stationary requirements, specialised equipment such as IT or Art supplies or Hospitality uniforms. It may include costs for excursions, camps, access to academic competitions, or school uniforms including shoes, ties and blazers. It may be provided for one item or several items within this category.

♥ Extra-Curricula

The Extra-curricula category may include, but is not limited to, sporting equipment, sport uniforms, tuition costs, training or transport costs. It may include equipment for music, the arts, or it may be for camps, tours, or to cover the costs of representative teams. It may also be used for sign up or registration fees for a sporting season, competition, debating, or some element of the arts. It may be provided for one item or several items within this category.

Round 4 Specific details

Round 4 will award up to 40 scholarships in total Australia wide.

- Applications can only be submitted by a person over 18 years of age.
- Applications must be completed by either:
 - the Parent or authorised Guardian of the child; or
 - an authorised Social Worker, GP, School Principal, Counsellor
- Applications must be co-signed by both the Parent / Guardian of the Child AND the Social Worker, GP, School Principal or Counsellor.
- Children must be between the ages of 5 and 18 years of age at date of application.
- Successful Applicants must provide Receipts with proof of purchase within fourteen (14) days of funds being paid for auditing purposes.
